### IMPROVE QUALITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS

The project aims to adapt Higher Education Institutions (HEI) and Vocational Education and Training (VET) Providers to the labour market requirements by improving the functioning of teaching quality management systems at the national and international levels.

### INTRODUCING THE PR3 QUICK SCAN TOOL



### HOW IT WORKS

- The PR3 Quick Scan is an innovative self-assessment tool developed under the QA-HEVET Project to support Vocational Education and Training (VET) providers and Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) in improving their quality assurance processes. By providing an easy-to-use framework for evaluation, the tool helps institutions identify strengths and areas for improvement in line with ESG (Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area) and EQAVET (European Quality Assurance in VET).

- Institutions complete an online self-assessment using structured quality indicators.
- A spider graph visually represents their performance across key quality areas.
- The tool suggests best practices and recommendations for areas needing improvement.
- Users can rate and refine suggested improvements based on their applicability and relevance.

The Quick Scan tool has been successfully piloted across multiple European institutions. The pilot phase involved HEIs and VET providers who tested the tool, providing valuable feedback that allowed for fine-tuning and optimization. This extensive evaluation ensured that the tool is practical, user-friendly, and aligned with real-world quality assurance needs.

With the testing phase completed, the tool is now fully operational and accessible online for institutions seeking to enhance their quality assurance frameworks.
