**Kick-off meeting: 14-15.07.2022**

**Location: Greece, Larissa, DIMITRA Education&Training**

The kick-off meeting of the QA-HEVET project took place on July 14-15, 2022, in Larissa, Greece. The event was attended by all project's consortium institutions, namely WULS-SGGW (Poland), DIMITRA (Greece), TUCEP (Italy), Folkuniversitetet Uppsala (Sweden) and Emphasis (CYPRUS) in a hybrid form (some partners team members were connected online). Meeting the partners and getting first-hand information on their professional activities was a brilliant opportunity. The primary goal of the meeting was to exhibit the roles and tasks of the cooperating institutions within the project. During the fruitful sessions, all cooperating organizations demonstrated total commitment to the ideas of the project and shared their unique expertise relevant to it. Partners presented their personal work and experience in the quality assurance area as well as in similar projects, discussed the overall project aims and related legal documents in involved countries, and set deadlines in order to start implementing the project.

During the meeting, we also discussed one by one all project tasks, and we led a discussion on project management, quality assurance, administrative and financial coordination, periodic consortium communication, dissemination strategy and activities, and other relevant to project issues. So our project can be considered to be gaining momentum!

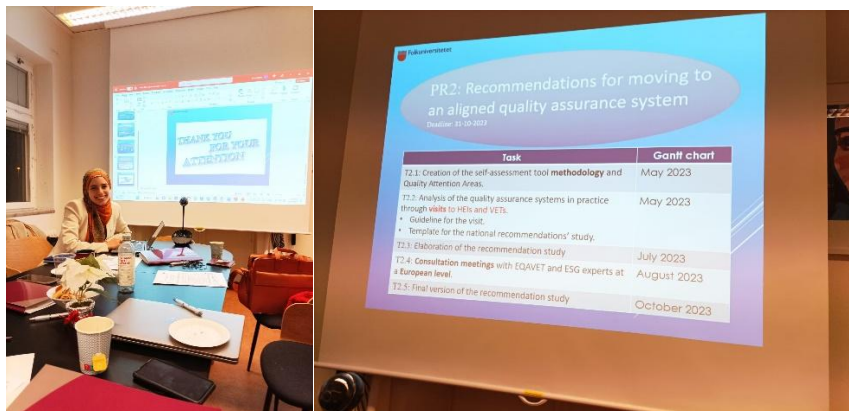

**TPM2: 16-17.02.2023**

**Location: Sweden, Upsala, FolkUniversitet**

The second transnational meeting of the QA-HEVET project took place on February 16-17, 2023, in Upsala, Sweden, at Folkuniversitet. During the meeting, the current status of the project was summarized: the implementation of the project results, the involvement of the various partners, project management issues, quality assurance, and dissemination activities. During a brief discussion, the partners indicated the most sensitive areas of the project course and the representative of each organization briefly characterized the results of the desk research on the quality assurance schemes in HEIs and VETs in their countries. Among other things, the general situation of HE and VET at a national level and policy for quality assurance at different levels were discussed. Participants shared their experiences with the differences, similarities, strengths, and weaknesses of the ESG and EQAVET framework. Moreover, the partners briefly presented the course and main conclusions of the online focus groups conducted with representatives of the HEIs and VET providers in their countries. The future plans in terms of dissemination activities, e.g., QA-HEVET on social media, project website, project newsletter, press releases, and leaflets, were raised. The meeting was very successful and ended with an assignment of the next steps, tasks and activities.
